It is against the Municipal Code for any unlicensed or inoperable vehicle to remain on any premise for more than 30 days. At the February meeting, the board will meet with Lone Tree Towing to discuss towing vehicles in violation that the owner has not removed. If your property is placed in nuisance abatement and is not remedied by yourself, the board can remedy the abatement and charge the homeowner for any costs.

This Nuisance Abatement Procedure was put into place in 2017. If anyone wants to see the items that would make a property a nuisance, you can stop in the Village Office to look at the Municipal Code Book. If you have a project you are working on and it should be exempt from Nuisance abatement, please discuss this with Code Enforcement Officer Grause or the Village Office.
