Pet Licenses are now Past Due

Pet Licenses are due by January 1st each year. In the event an owner fails to voluntarily acquire a license by January 1st, the fee for the license, until January 31, shall be **twice the license fee**. In the event an owner fails to voluntarily acquire a license by January 31, he or she **shall pay a charge of \$50.00 per animal in addition to the fees required** by this division. The total late fees shall be capped at \$100.00 per household.
