Nebraska's New Voter ID law (LB514)

The first Nebraska election requiring voter ID will be the statewide primary in 2024: **May 14, 2024**

All elections in Nebraska after that will require Voter ID. Merrick County has voting by mail. You will need to include information on your ballot.
