Do you know...

What you do on your property that you would need a permit for?

With the change in weather getting nicer, there may be projects that you will do at your property. Do you know certain things require a permit from the Village or the Planning & Zoning Board. The following is a list of items that needs to have a permit completed and approved before doing a project.

- 1. **Zoning Permit** Needed when you change the outside of your house. Additions, decks, storage sheds, detached garage, chicken coop, decks, fences. If you wonder if it needs a permit, check with the Village Clerk first to see if it is required. No fee for this permit
- 2. **Fowl Application -** If you live in village limits and want to raise chickens, geese, or any fowl; an application needs to be submitted and renewed annually to have them on your property. This was changed in November 2023. The annual fee is \$10.
- 3. **Well Permit** If you would like to have a well dug for irrigation, a permit would need to be filled out and approved by the Village Board at their monthly meeting. Wells will need to have proper backflow prevention added to meet State Regulations. No fee for this permit
- 4. **Demolition Permit** If you want to take down an accessory building on your property or a vacant building, you will need to file a demo permit with the Village Office. This information then updates the County Assessor's files for your property taxes. *All property taxes owed need to be current with the County Assessor before a building can be demolished.* No fee for this permit

The Municipal Code Book was updated by the Village Board Members in February 2024. It had previously been 20 years since the last code book changes had been codified. These forms are also available on the Village website at www.villageofclarks.com. The Planning & Zoning Regulations, Municipal Code Book and Comprehensive Plan can also be viewed on the website.
