Informational Meeting of the Village of Clarks Board Trustees

The Clarks Board Trustees are holding an informational meeting to discuss changes to water and sewer rates. Municipality budgets are due on September 30th each year. As the budget is being considered for approval by the Board Trustees, the accountant has brought it to the attention of the trustees that some changes need made to the rates. The board has a couple options on how to proceed with changes. They would like to have people come to the meeting on September 11th at 7 p.m. Our accountant will be at the meeting to answer any questions that the public might have.

The Nebraska Rural Water Association did an updated water rate study on August 14th. The last rate study was done 2 & 1/2 years ago when rates had to be changed to cover costs to run the Water Treatment Plant. The rates still do not cover what the costs are to run the plant.
